The sponsor's task does not end when the teen is confirmed; rather, the sponsor is obligated to help the teen "grow in faith," to help in his or her Christian walk throughout life, and to seek out the candidate if he or she ever goes astray.

At the time of the anointing, you will follow your candidate to the Bishop with your left hand on their left shoulder. Your candidate will make their request to be confirmed, they will be anointed with the Oil of Chrism and receive the fullness of the Spirit. You will both return to your seats.

Thank you for accepting this honour and responsibility of being a Confirmation Sponsor. May the Holy Spirit inspire and encourage you as you accompany your candidate on the journey to the fullness of life in Christ. May this be a graced time.
