- 1. Youth Ministry
 - Nicole McCowell (Hamilton Diocese Director of Youth Ministry) facilitated this portion of the meeting.
 - Current State of Accompaniment of Young People questionnaire was distributed as to the current state of youth ministry in our parish:
 - The following are ongoing: Children's Sunday Liturgy; classroom visitations by our priests; altar serving of young kids.
 - Notable improvements have been seen with young families going to church; increase in young adult presence in the church in the last 6 months.
 - Suggestions and discussions for Youth Ministry to thrive:
 - a) Post Confirmation follow-up: invest time starting with Gr.7-12.
 - b) Opportunities to read at Masses; involvement in volunteer work; church involvement as option.c) Possibility of hiring part time Youth Minister.
 - d) Gather current list of young people: e.g. Confirmandi
 - e) Budget for food anytime youth are gathered.

f) Prioritize personal conversations with youth to understand their needs, and ensure parish follows through with programming.

- 4. Divine Mercy Sunday activities
 - Fr. Arpee to discuss with Evelyn Suva.
- 5. Discussing time and term limits for volunteers

 - The Outreach Committee works hand-in-hand with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.
 - The Program continues to run and is in need of support through donations.
 - They are requesting organized volunteers at special times (like Christmas) to help distribute donations and gift cards.
 - They plan to submit a write-up about this program, its resources, and its need for more community support.
